- 5) To comply with all relevant legislation governing Occupational Safety and Health in Zimbabwe
- 6) To ensure contractors, visitors or customers hired by the Company fully comply with all aspects of THE WATTLE COMPANY Safety and Health Policy.
- 7) To ensure continual review of the Safety & Health Policy for continual improvement.
- 8) To Identify, assess and control all existing and new hazards in the workplace to which employees and others are or may be exposed.
- 9) To provide information, training and equipment appropriate for controlling all hazards, particularly those hazards assessed as being significant.
